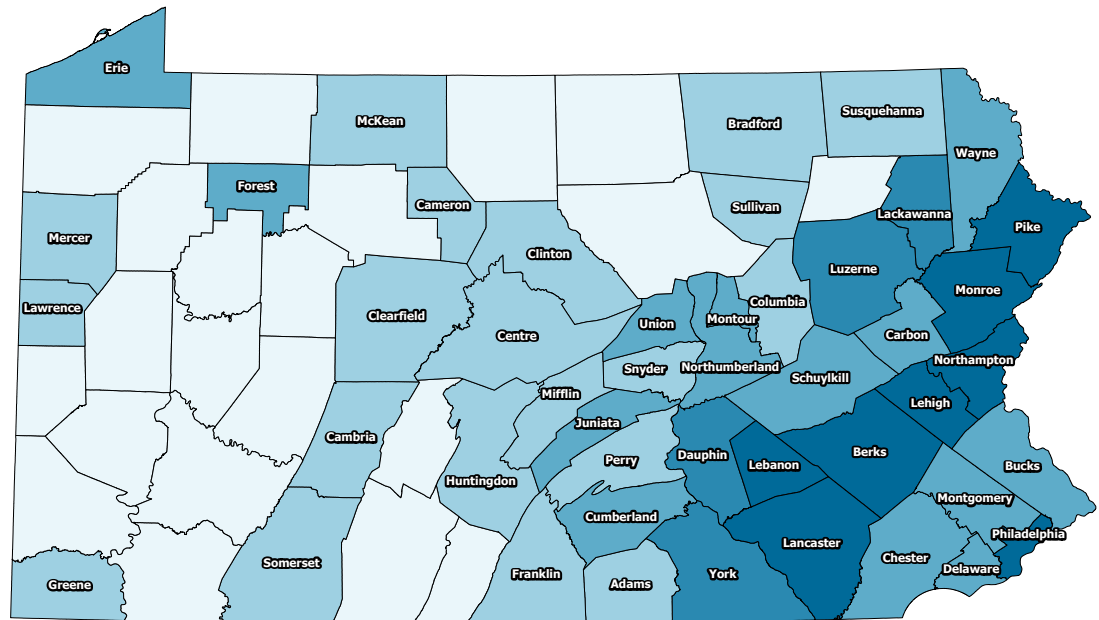
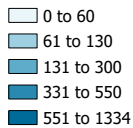









## Puerto Rican Population
