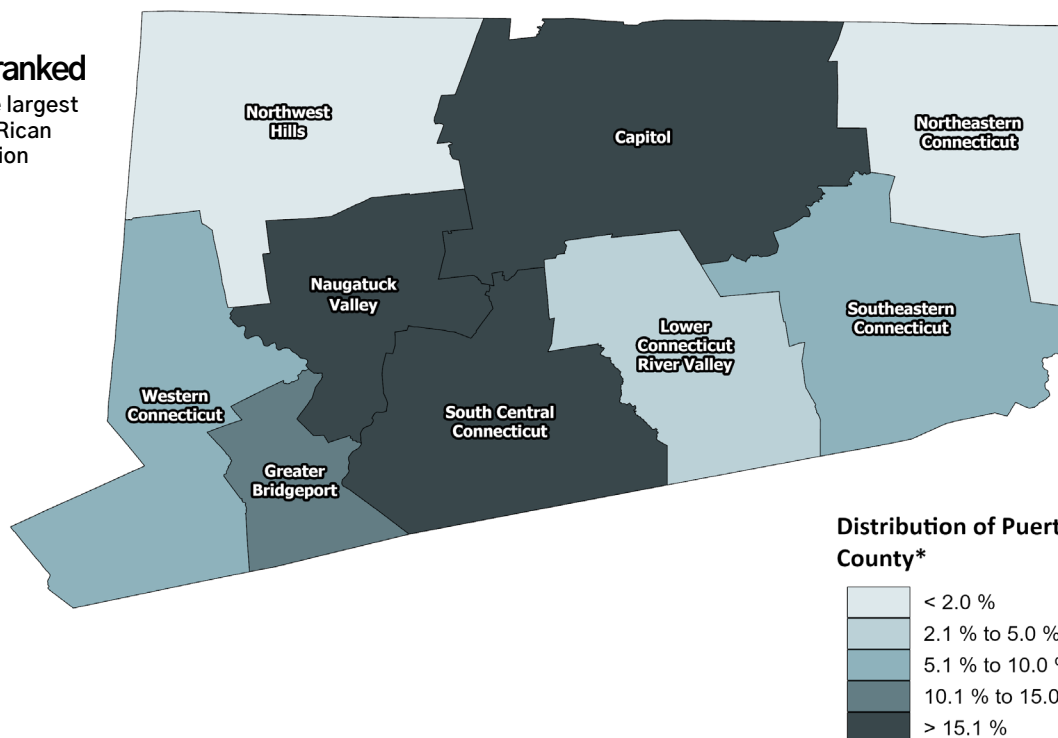


## Connecticut is ranked **#6** with the largest Puerto Rican population
