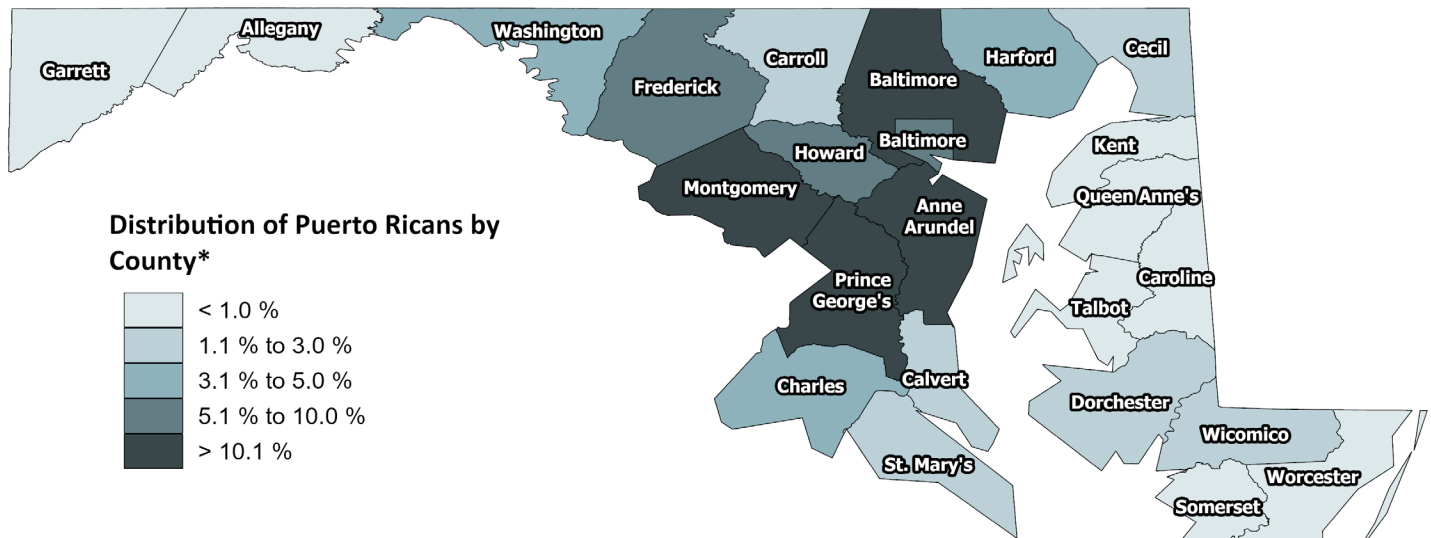


Maryland is ranked


