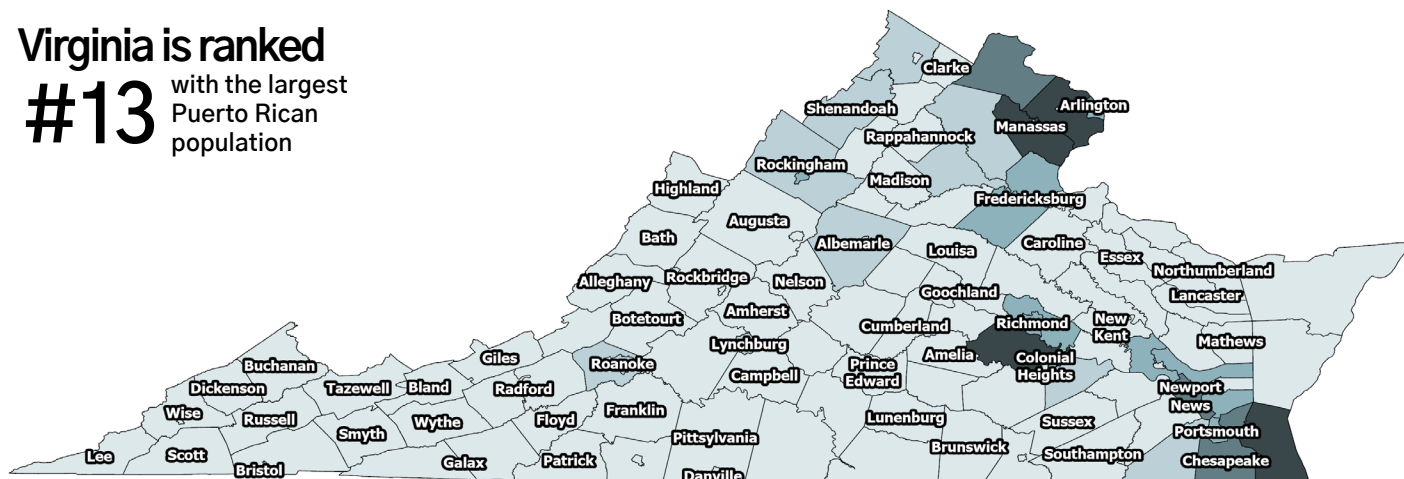
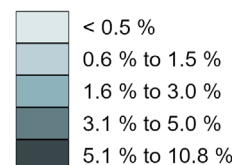


Virginia is ranked
